





A Review of Requirements for CS1

Prerequisite: Professional healthcare practitioner, student in healthcare program or graduate awaiting licensure/accreditation with experience in sensitive, light-touch palpation.

For those who wish to take CS1, and live in a state or province that does not require a healthcare hands-on license to practice CST, the following minimum study is required:

- 80 hours of Anatomy and Physiology and 15 hours of Pathology. One way to satisfy this requirement is through the home study coursework, <u>Upledger Health Science</u> <u>Essentials</u>, available through the London (Ontario) College of Osteopathy.
- 4 hours of ethics, from an accredited organization school that meets ethics credit requirements.
